
# Key Issues

  - Distance learning


# Kinds of ABE Programming

- Core CCRS, ACES, NorthStar Digital Literacy Standards, (civics, diploma/GED prep, test prep)
- Bridge contextualized to a sector or related sectors and designed to prepare participants for participation in career pathways specific pathways
- Integrated literacy skills support provided concurrently (just-in-time) with occupational training (IET), work, academic (dev ed)
- Occupational Training ideally provided by partners (non-duplicative), should always include integrated literacy skills



## Federal Aid




# Average Hours Per Enrollee


