



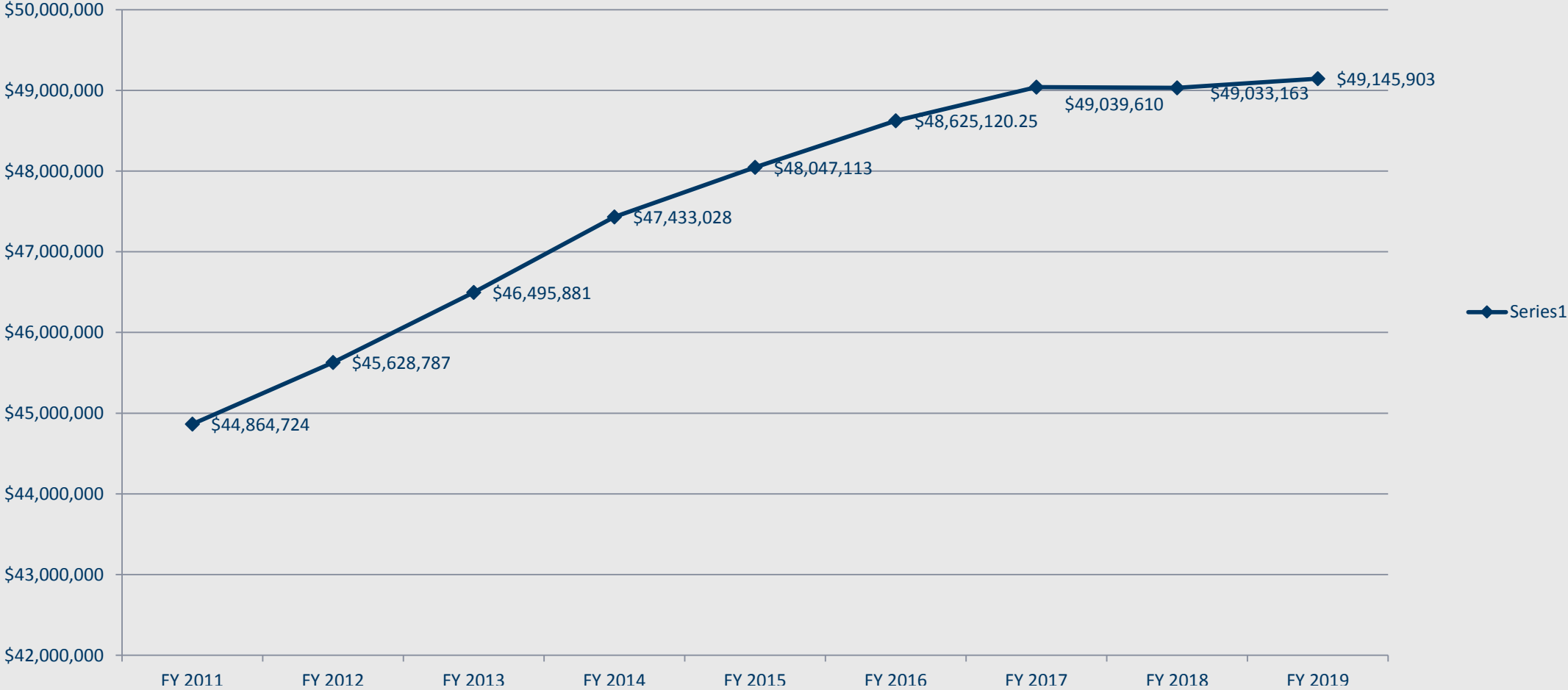

Kinds of ABE Programming

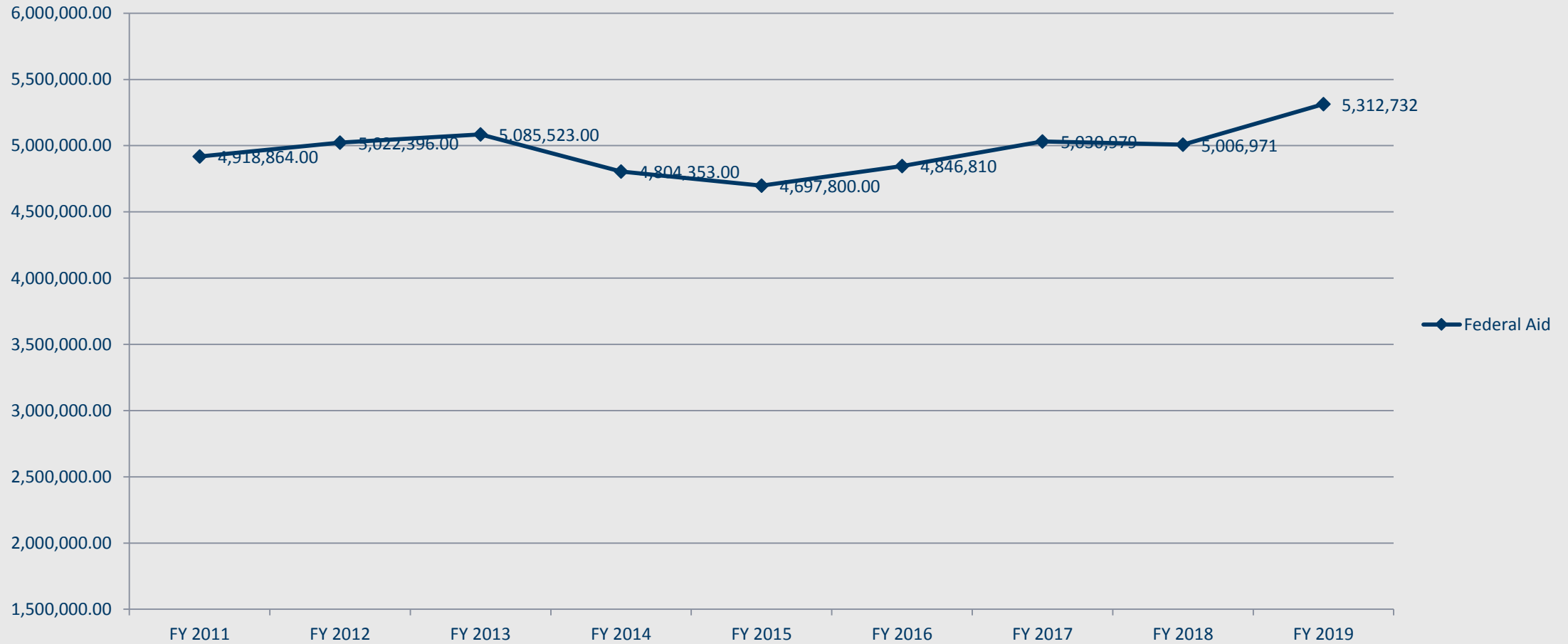
- Core – CCRS, ACES, NorthStar Digital Literacy Standards, (civics, diploma/GED prep, test prep)
- Bridge – contextualized to a sector or related sectors and designed to prepare participants for participation in career pathways specific pathways
- Integrated – literacy skills support provided concurrently (just-in-time) with occupational training (IET), work, academic (dev ed)
- Occupational Training – ideally provided by partners (non-duplicative), should always include integrated literacy skills

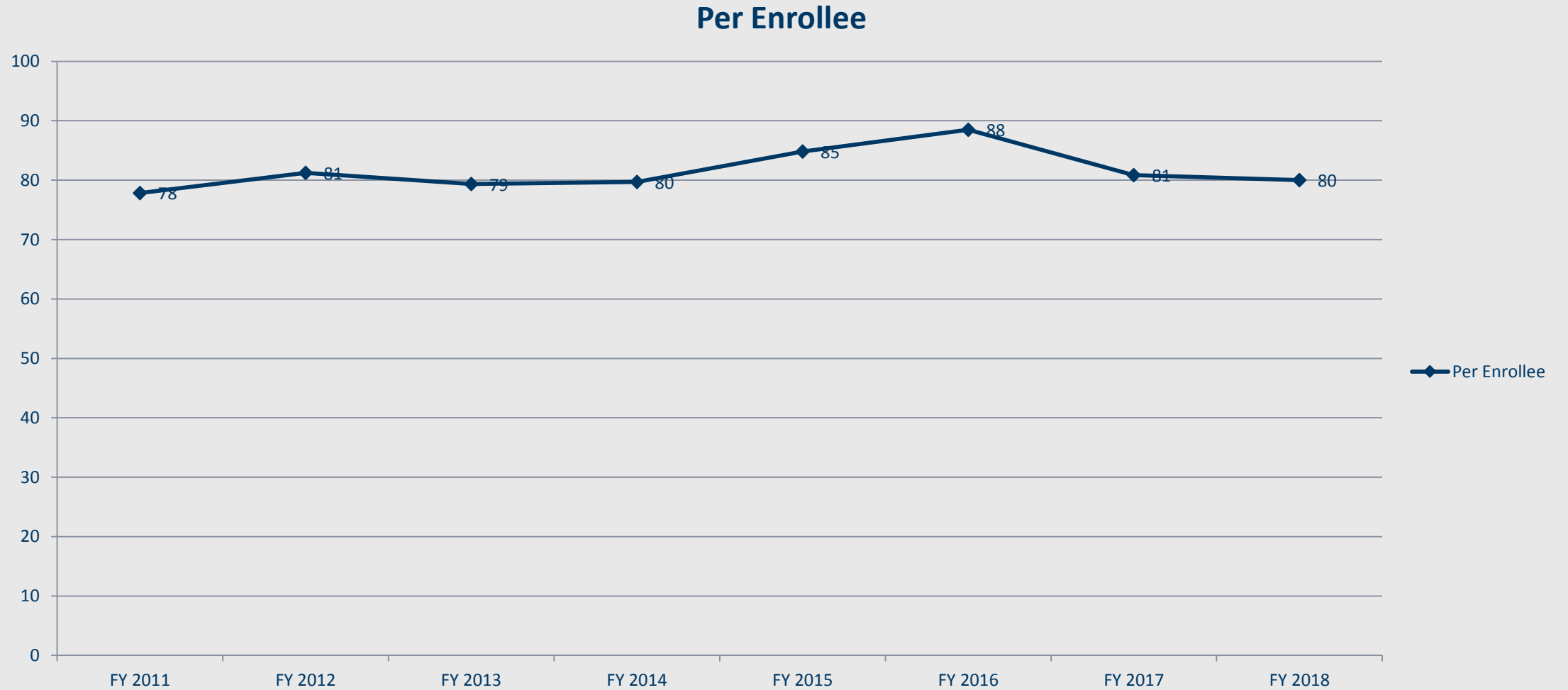

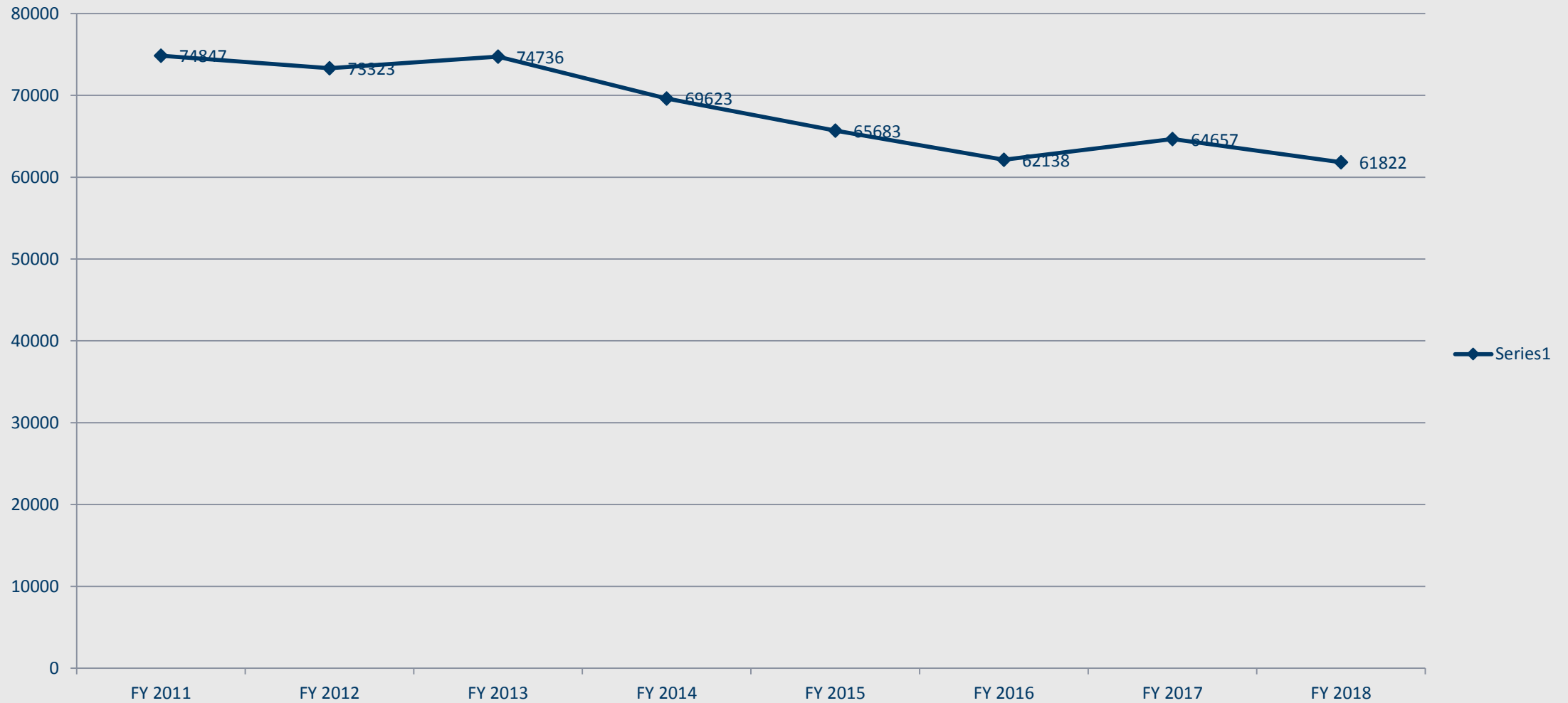

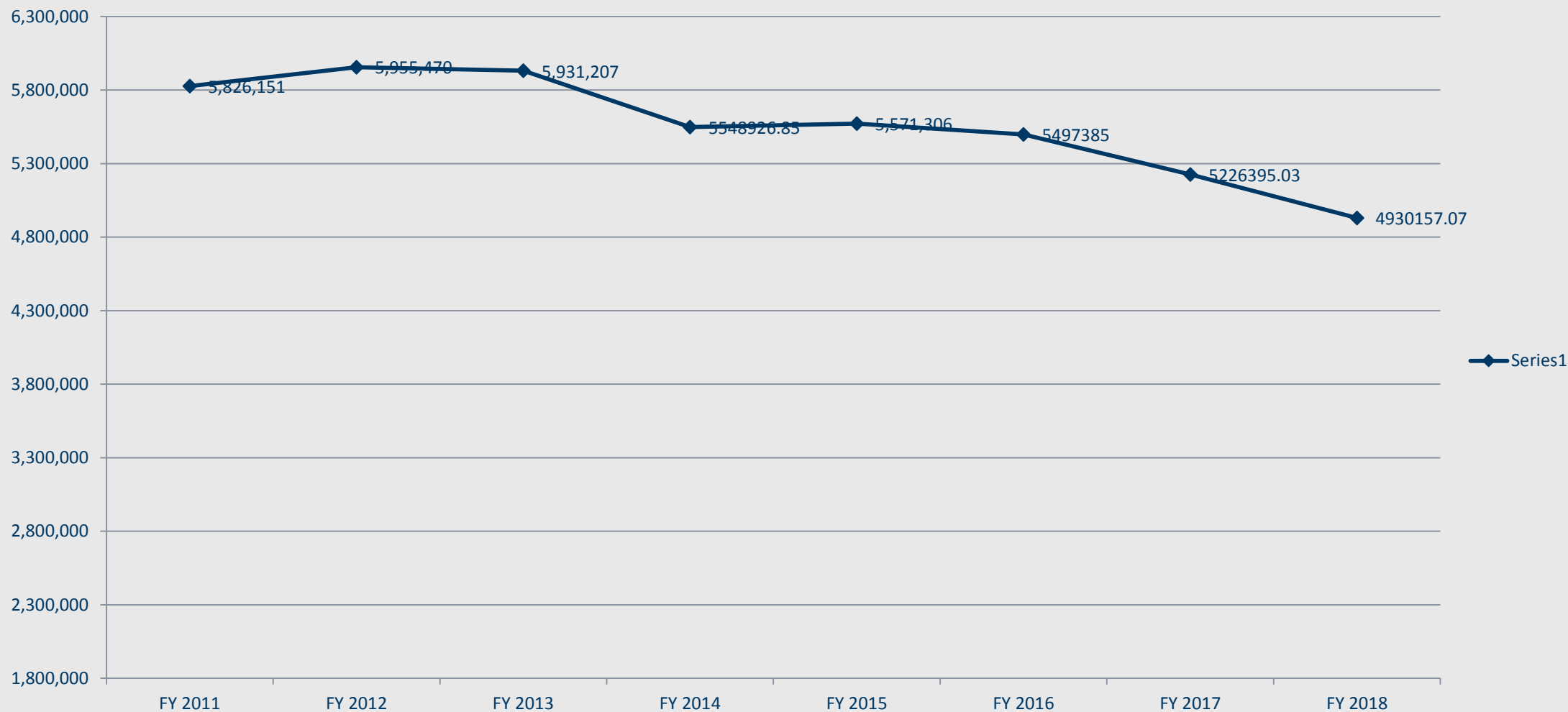
Average Hours Per Enrollee



Enrollees



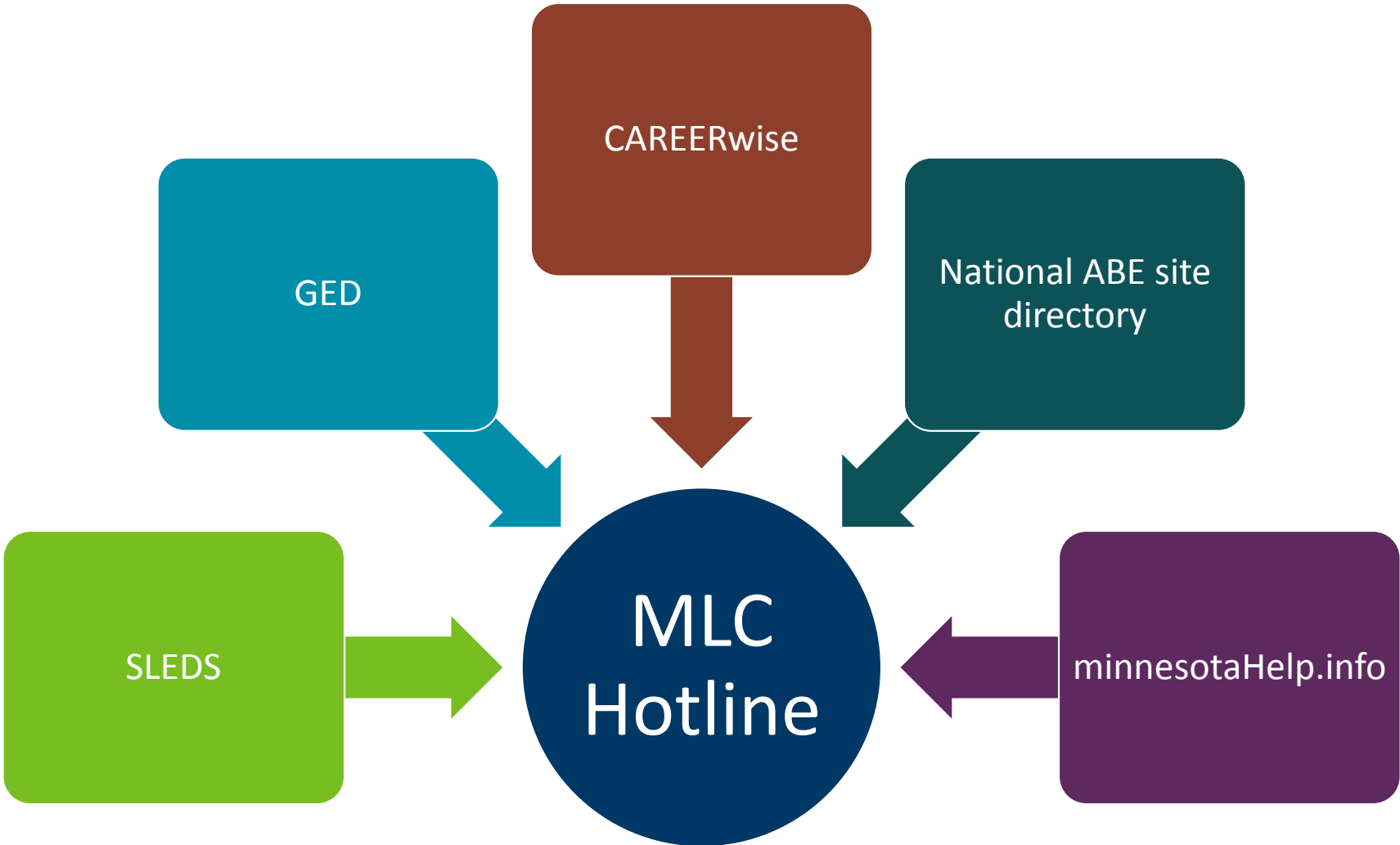
