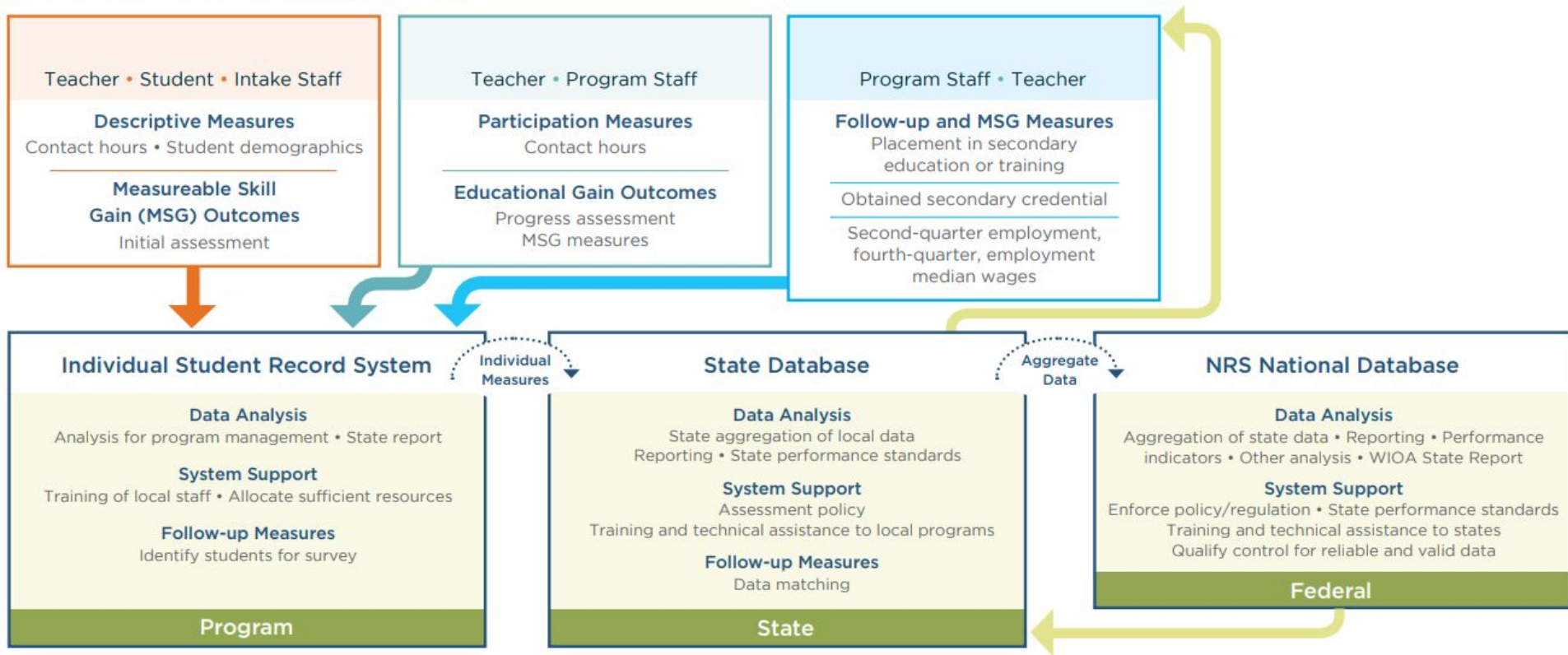

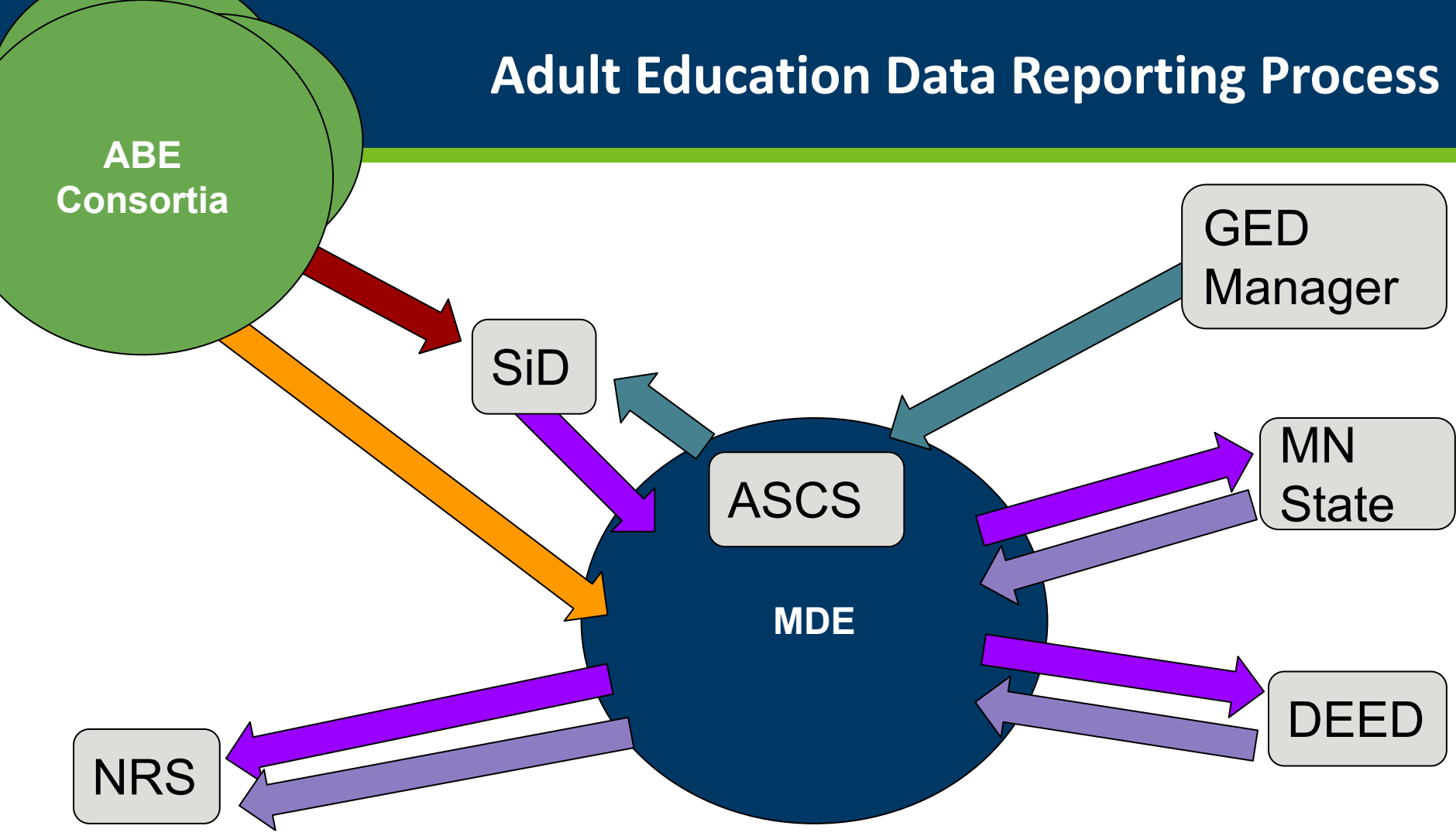

Simplified Steps in the Data Reporting Process

1. ABE staff enter data in SiD
2. GED data added to SiD by MDE staff
3. ABE programs send MDE reports
4. SiD staff send data extracts and reports to MDE
5. MDE staff repackage extracts and forward to DEED and MN State
6. DEED and MN State staff send reports to MDE
7. MDE staff analyze and repackage reports from ABE programs, SiD, DEED and MN State
8. MDE staff enter data to NRS
