





- 2. GED data added to SiD by MDE staff
- 3. ABE programs send MDE reports
- 4. SiD staff send data extracts and reports to MDE
- 5. MDE staff repackage extracts and forward to DEED and MN State
- 6. DEED and MN State staff send reports to MDE
- 7. MDE staff analyze and repackage reports from ABE programs, SiD, DEED and MN State
- 8. MDE staff enter data to NRS
